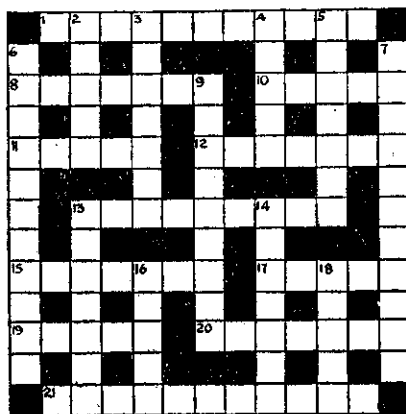

PACKING PARCELS?

Remember the three wells



Liquids, or soft fruit which is likely to pulp, should be in a liquid-tight container, packed in absorbent material. When you pack anything with sharp edges make sure it will not pierce the package. Matches or other explosive articles must not be sent through the post. Use special care in packing overseas parcels.

Use a tie-on label as well as addressing the package. Address clearly, preferably in BLOCK letters. Sender's name should also appear on the package or on a slip inside. IF IT'S WORTH SENDING—IT'S WORTH PACKING WELL!
