

In New Zealand very large numbers of people are served by rural mail deliveries. This service has been so expanded within the last ten years that today over 47,000 individual boxholders are served by Post Office rural deliveries. This means that of the 300 million postal articles handled by the Post Office each year, a large proportion—many millions—go to rural boxholders. Mail for rural delivery, particularly from cities and towns, is often incompletely addressed. The possibility of delay and confusion will be avoided if you address fully. Remember, there may be several rural deliveries operating from one place. Use locality names if you wish, but make sure you use the name of the rural delivery.
