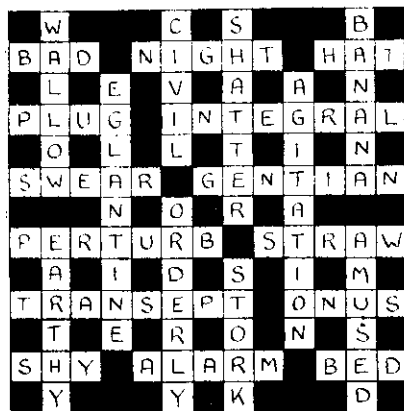

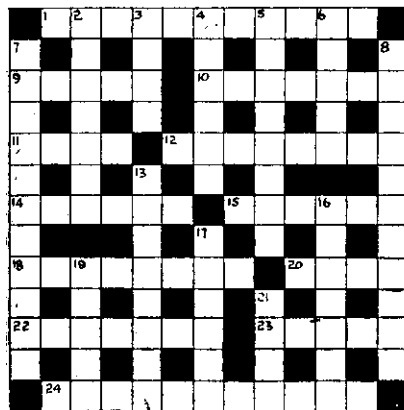

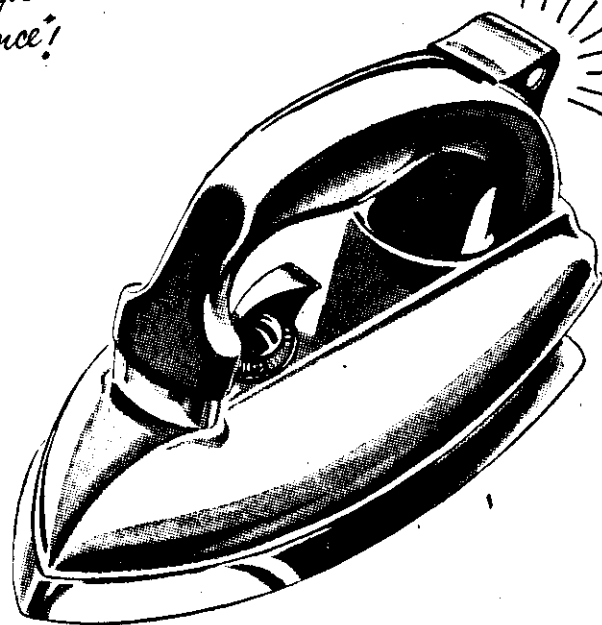
## Singers from Palmerston
