 To most of us the name of the Italian, Ferruccio Busoni, stands for one of the greatest pianists of the first quarter of this century and for the arranger of certain pianoforte versions of some of Bach's love-

best chorales. As a matter of fact, Busoni was a composer of great originality and considerable forcefulness, and would probably have wished to be remembered as much by his music as by his pianoforte playing. Fate, however, decreed otherwise. Though he died in 1924 his terrific pianistic powers are still spoken of with reverential awe, but apart from the Bach-Busoni arrangements his music is all but forgotten.
