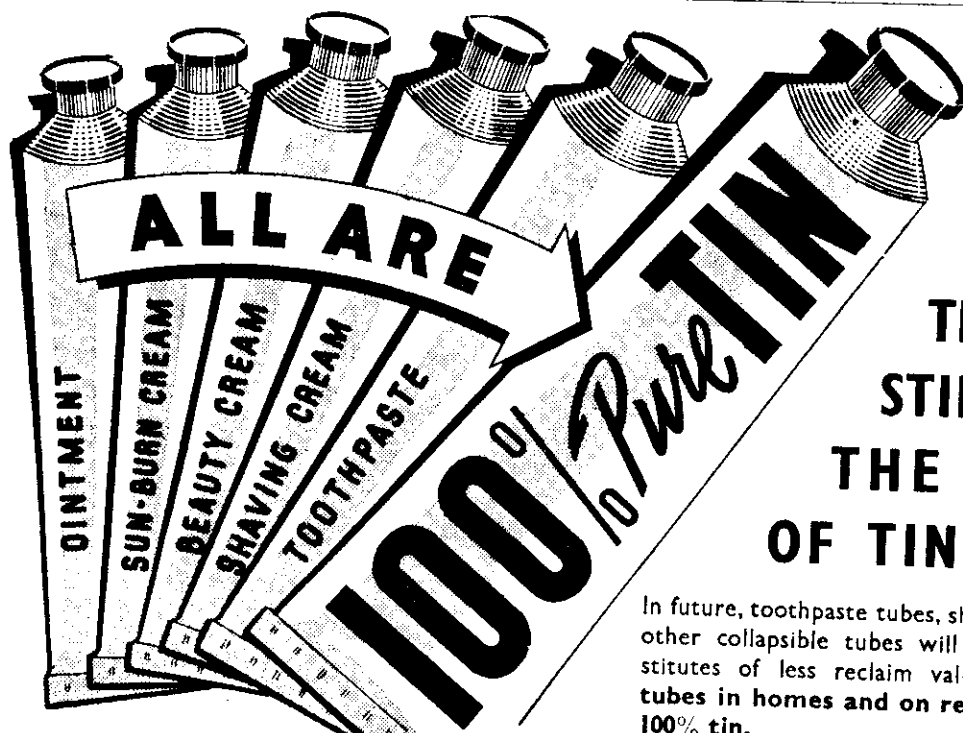

ALL PROCEEDS FROM SALE OF WASTE MATERIALS GO TO PATRIOTIC FUNDS.

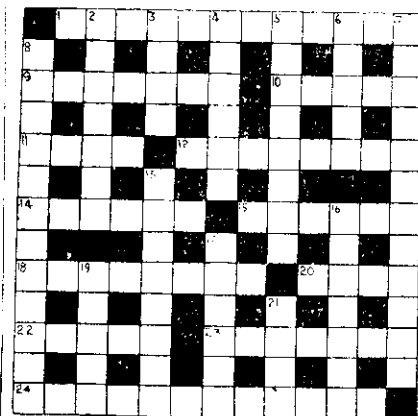

THE LISTENER CROSSWORD (No. 141: Constructed by R.W.C.)



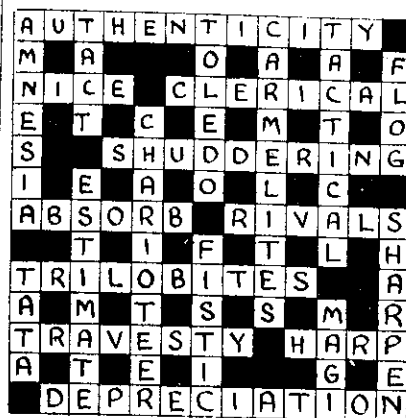
