The islands of the West Indies, apart from being popular tourist resorts, are famed for their calypso music and musicians. Before the war, a West Indian bandleader went to England to make a living leading his own West Indian Orrhestra at the renowned Cafe de Paris in London. His name was Ken Johnson, and his orrhestra dance hands in the early war years. At six o'clock this evening Station 3ZB will broadcast a selection of recordings by Ken Johnson and his West Indian Orchestra in the Tea Dance Session.
