

What is Bandspread?



Stations on an ordinary short wave




Stations on a Bandspread dial.

A Bandspread radio has the 'short-wave' magnified and then split up into a number of separate wavebands. Each of these wavebands (there are seven apart from Broadcast on this fully bandspread set) occupies the same space on the dial as the short wave on an ordinary set. Because the so-called 'short wave' is about 16 times begger with bandspreading it's about 16 times easier to tune. Stations that were too close together and interfering with one another are easily separated. The pictures opposite tell the story. See how much easier it is to select a station on a bandspread dial (lower picture) than on an ordinary 'short wave' dial.
