

The Future of EDC

THE most important news of the week . . . is the news that the Lower House of the West German Parliament has voted for German rearmament and participation in the European Defence Community. In this alphabetical age, this has come to be known as EDC. EDC consists of France, Italy, Belgium, the Netherlands, Luxembourg and West Germany, Or, rather . . . it may consist of these countries if they ratify it.

EDC is an arrangement for the defence of West Europe with a common army in which French soldiers will train and fight beside German soldiers and beside Dutch soldiers, and so on, under a joint command.
