
Sir Thomas Beecham, English orchestral conductor, studied music at Oxford University. After conducting the duen's Hall Orchestra in 1905, he established and directed the New Symphony Orchestra from 1906 to 1908, after which the founded the Beecham Symphonic Orchestra. Early in 1910 he gave a season of Grand Opera in London, followed by two months of opera-comique in the spring, and another series of Grand Opera in the fall of the same year. The company continued from 1913 to 1916, after which Sir Thomas Beecham became artistic director of the Royal Philharmonic Orchestra and conductor of numerous orchestras.
