He was in the U.S. Navy for 3 years, and on being demobbed joined Frankie Laine in 1946 as arranger-conductor-accompanist, and in 1952-53 he appeared with him during his Lonon Palladium seasons. Today at 4.30 from 3ZB Carl Fischer accompanies Frankie Laine.
