He spent much of his childhood in the midst of radio and stage world, and was educated at Syracuse, N.Y., Nottingham High School, and Deerfield Academy, Massachusetts. In 1940 he won a magazine-sponsored singing contest and two weeks' engagement at the Dancing Campus of N.Y. World's Fair as a vocalist with Harry Jamee's and Les Brown's Bands: then he joined Mill Pond, Long Island, Summer Theatre, to learn fundamentals of legitimate stage, Gordon MacRae will be heard at 4.15 from 4ZB.
