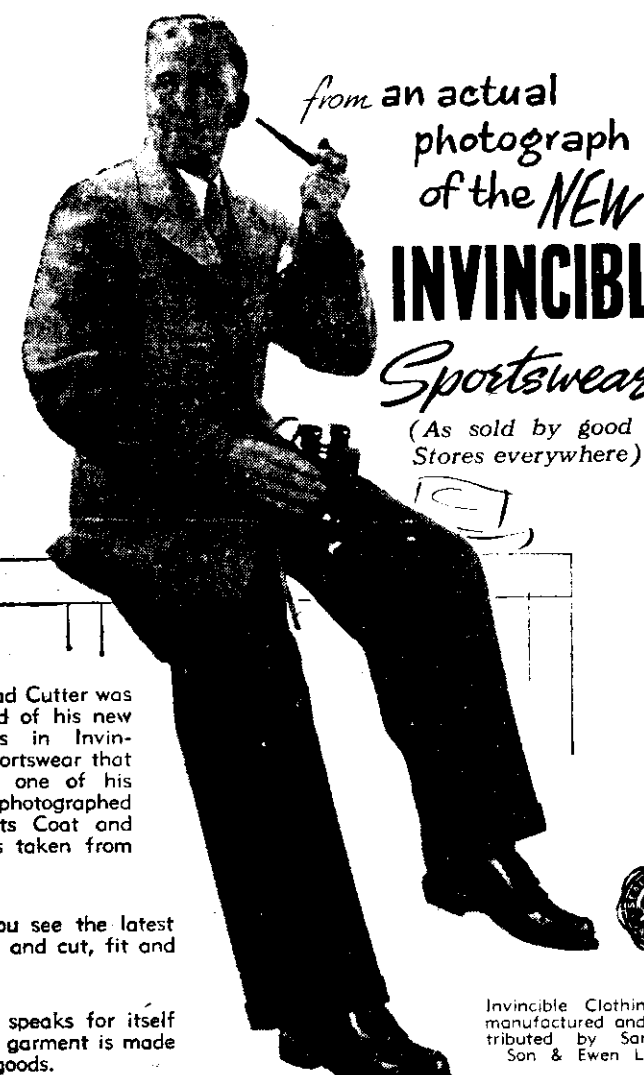

The Deutschmeister Band was founded in 1711, the year of the birth of Emperor Josef, famous liberal ruler of the Austrian monarchy. It served as a band for the famous Deutschmeister Regiment, which was the Vienna house regiment of the Emperor, and eventually the band became part and parcel of the Vienna musical culture. So strong was the feeling of the Viennese for this famous band that when, after World War I, the monarchy collapsed, and all military regiments were disbanded, the band remained. The Deutschmeister Band may be heard from 3ZB at 5.45.
