

great delicacy. (It is interesting that the meaning assigned to "love" is progressively narrowing in the hands of present-day novelists.)

It is perhaps a little hard on a local writer to judge her work alongside two such slick performers as Garnett and Paule Lafeuille, but our own novelists will never be worth much if they have to be judged by special standards. (Nor will we develop a responsible criticism by maintaining a double standard.) Shadowed Journey is written round the Tangiwai disaster, and the use made of this event in developing the plot is ingenious. But the treatment and characterisation are wooden and the dialogue is realistic enough to be banal.

The short story seems now to be a living art only in America. Mrs. Patton reproduces perfectly the vigorous, wise-cracking brightness of the best American conversation. Her stories are good and refreshingly varied. Their insights into human nature are at a higher level than those of most contemporary novelists.


