Model 2010 Transcription Unit

Model 2010 is mounted on a rectangular unit plate and is equipped with a STUDIO "PX" High Fidelity pickup head, comprising a special low resonance arm and special bearing.

Turntable—specially balanced non-magnetic turntable with a weight of approximately 8½ lbs. and is fitted with a rubber turntable mat. The weight of the turntable is so disposed that the majority of the weight is at the periphery thus giving a flywheel effect.

Motor—available for AC voltages of 200/250 volts at 50 cycles per second. Silent running and with absolutely "wow"-free performance.

Three Speed Gear—an entirely new type of 3-speed mechanism has been designed to give absolutely uniform turntable speed, while improved technique in the construction and assembly of the motor ensures reproduction free from rumble and frequency modulation.

Pickup—It is fitted with a tubular metal arm which has a very low resonance and the arm is so designed as to be capable of playing 16 inch records.

The pickup insert is housed in a new attractive head moulding which is fitted with finger tip control to enable the pickup to be placed accurately and carefully on the record. An adjusting screw is fitted to the unit plate adjacent to the pickup base to give free suspension of pickup support.

Speed Change and "Off" Switch—conveniently situated on the right-hand side of the unit plate. There is an "OFF" position between each speed. Switching the unit from one speed to another automatically switches off the motor during the speed change. Switching to any speed automatically starts the motor.

45 R.P.M. Adaptor—This adaptor is permanently spring-loaded on the turntable and no other fittings are required for playing 7 inch 45 R.P.M. records with large centre holes.

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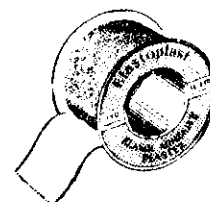
