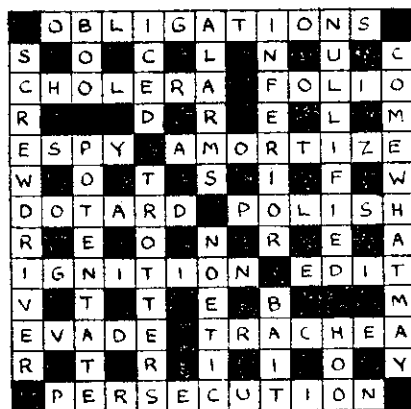


"THE LISTENER" CROSSWORD

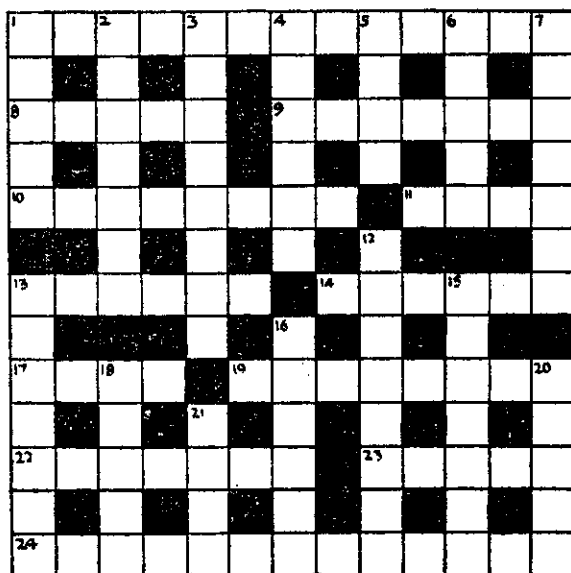

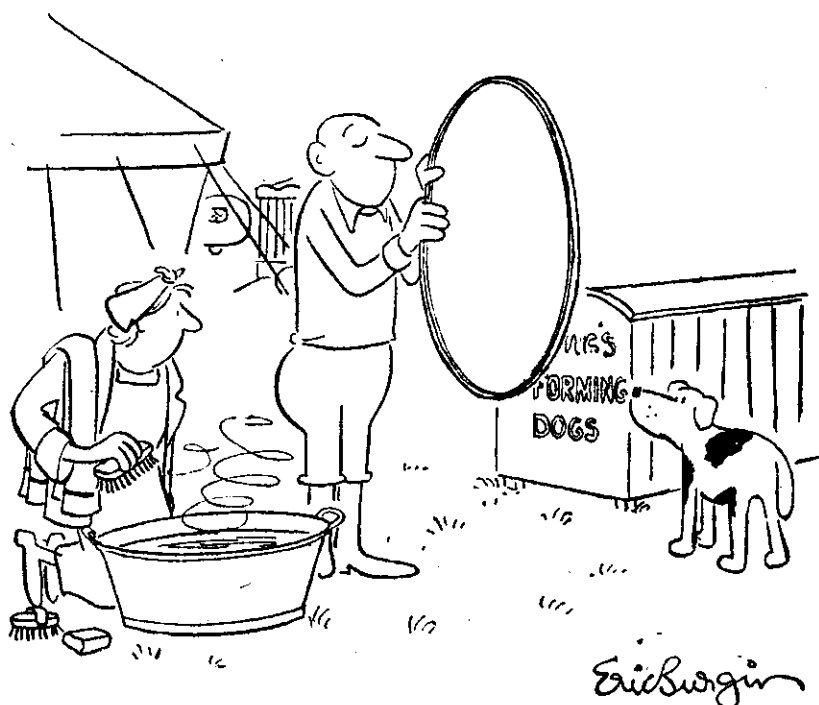
