

Papadopoulos dies while coolly picking off with his rifle members of a large detachment of police which has been sent out to silence him. Heroic? And a trifle theatrical. But perhaps the presence of the three travellers, who rather self-consciously commentate and sympathise-somewhat in the manner of a Greek chorus-accounts for that.

It is hard also for a reader to find a way through the maze of atmospherics that surround the book's other characters---Jim, the egotistical ex-trapeze artist, Ronnie, the consumptive oboeplayer. Eric, the overdressed racketeer. and those beautiful, seductive women. Dora, Patsy, Mabs and Flo. But it is worth persisting until the end, for a deeper significance is hinted at continually in the story: "It's as easy as a leaf turning in the wind for a good person to become evil," says Charlie. The novel tries to focus some of the moral problems of the contemporary -P.J.W.
