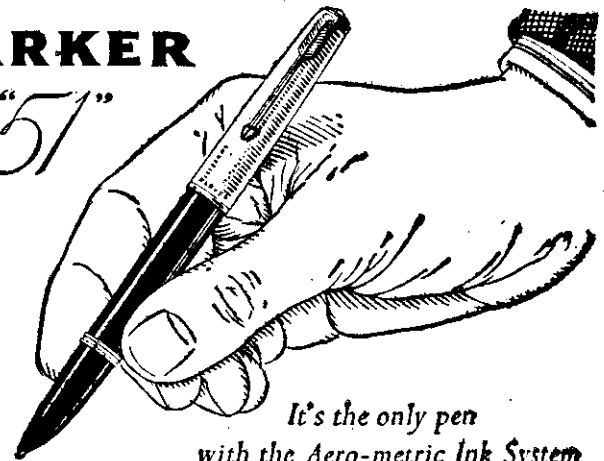
Dunedin listeners should tune into 4ZB at 6.30 each Wednesday to "Local Colour," which features local entertainers

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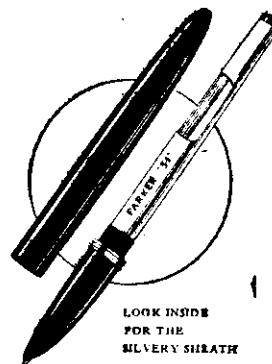
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
