
16,400 NEW HOMES BUILT a Record of Achievement

11,900 HOUSES BUILT IN ONE YEAR BY PRIVATE ENTERPRISE

Loans were increased from £1500 to £2000. In addition a suspensory loan of £200. This on houses not exceeding £2200. This becomes a free gift subject to compliance with certain conditions.

Loans last year amounted to £7,700,000an increase of £4,700,000 on 1949-50.

4,930 STATE HOUSES TO BE BUILT

Last year 4,500 State houses were built. Since March 31st, 633 more houses have been completed, 2,130 are in construction and contracts let or approved for another 2,167.
