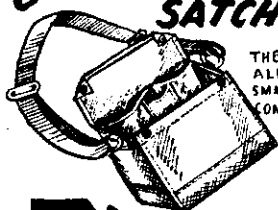
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The Vienna Boys' Choir, which was formed nearly 450 years ago, is today rapidly regaining its pre-war position as one of the world's finest vocal groups. They toured Australia and N.Z. just before the war, and on the outbreak of hostilities had to remain in Australia, most of them being absorbed into the choir of St. Patrick's Cathedral, Melbourne. 2ZB presents a recorded recital by this group at 4.15 this afternoon.

The spotlight will be on two Australian women in 2ZA's 10.15 session this morning, when Anona Winn and Marie Ormston take over for 15 minutes. Anona is a name of Red Indian origin, meaning "Harvest of Good Things." She is well known on the BBC's "Twenty Questions," and strikes home with the winning question more often than any of her three colleagues. Anona Winn will be heard in songs, and the other Sydneysider, Marie Ormston, is the featured pianist in this morning's session.

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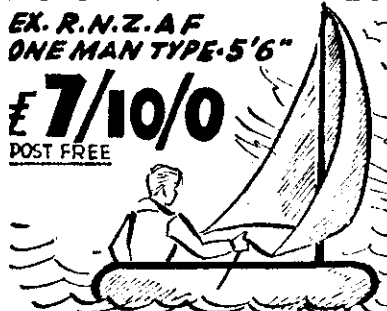
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
