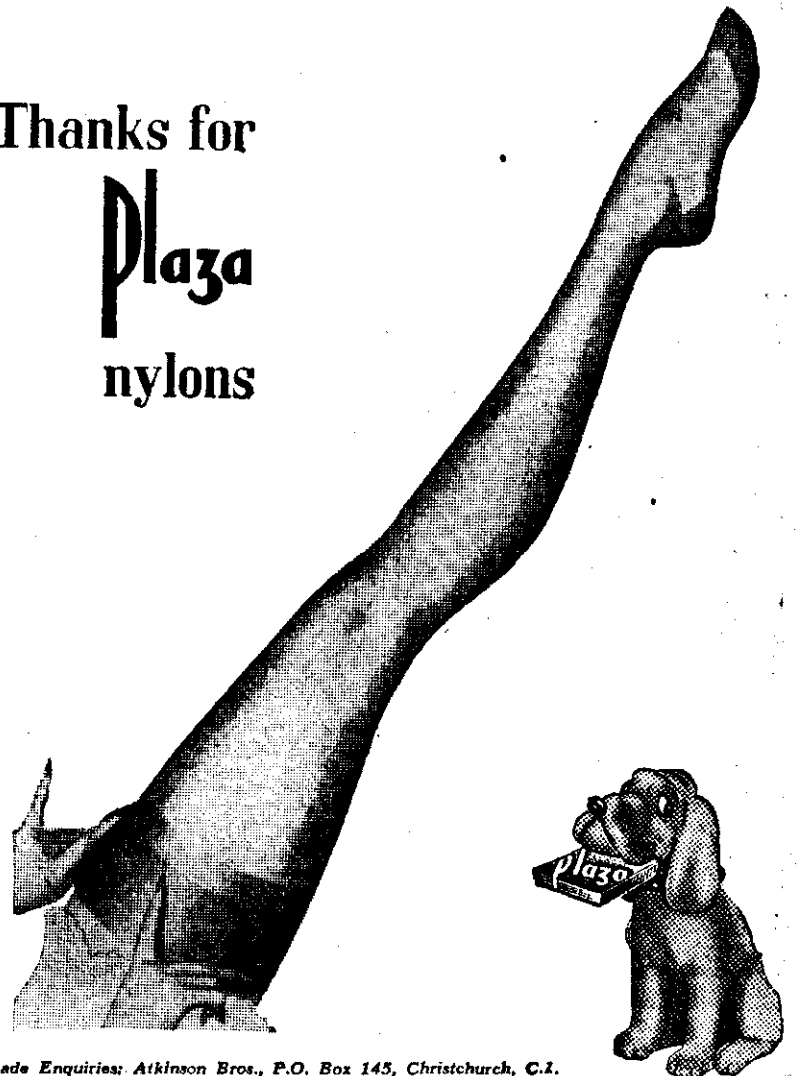
Trade names appearing in Commercial Division programmes are published by arrangement.
