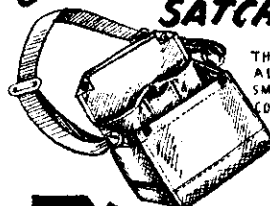

The British public have always displayed loyalty to their favourites in the entertainment world. When new stars appear in the musical firmament they are judged on their merits, and welcomed accordingly. A comparative newcomer to British stage and radio, who has already made the grade, is the celebrated Canadian conductor and composer Robert Farnon, now a Londoner by adoption. His orchestra, with associate artists, will be heard from 2ZA at 7.30 p.m.

Al Goodman was first introduced to musical comedy by the late Earl Carroll, who persuaded him to collaborate in producing his musical "So Long, Letty." This success, followed by the hit "Sinbad," which he produced with Al Jolson, led to positions as orchestra conductor for many Broadway shows, including "Flying High," "The Student Prince" and "Blossom Time." During this period of his career, Al Goodman directed over 150 first night performances, and became one of the Great White Way's most popular conductors. At 5.30 4ZB will bring you recordings by Al Goodman and his Orchestra.

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
