The touching fable of the "inventor of music" recovering his beloved Eurydice from Hades and losing her again in the moment of their reunion has been used more frequently than any other subject as an operatic libretto. Among the numerous operas based on this story are Gluck's Orfeo et Euridice (1752; and Monteverd's Orfeo (1607). It is interesting to note the difference beliveen the tragic, but heroic, close of Monteverd's opera and the happy ending of Cluck's. In the former, Orpheus loses Euridice, but, as a reward of his great love, is transferred to the starby Apollo; in the latter, Amor appears and restores Euridice to life. (Monteverd's "L'Orfeo" will be broadcast at 8.10 tomorrow)
