Station 2ZA will broadcast their final episode of "The Pearls of Vanikay" from the "Air Adventures of Biggles" series, at 7 o'clock tonight.

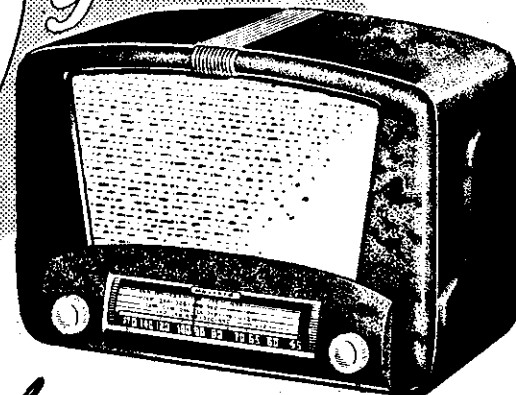
