American baritone John Charles Thomas began his operatic career in Brussels, having first had some success in New York musical comedy. He has since performed at most of the great American opera houses and has made many fine recordings, ranging from light ballads to Italian opera, some of which are to be broadcast from 1ZB today at 5.45 p.m.

The possessor of a mellow rich voice, and a prodigious memory, Burl Ives sings the old, old songs that Americans for generations have sung for the pure joy of singing, in the logging camps of the Nor'-West, the bunkhouses of the wide open spaces, the fishing villages of New England, and the plantations of the South. Burl Ives is the artist to be heard from 3ZB today at 3.45.

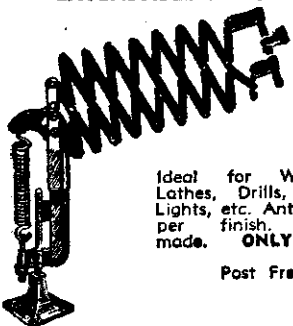
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
