Stanley Black, until recently conductor of the BBC Dance Orchestra, has had a varied career in popular music. Originally with Harry Roy's Orchestra and later Bert Ambrose, Black turned to orchestration before the war and soon formed an orchestra built around his effective piano stylings. This talented musician will be heard from 1ZB at 3.35 this afternoon.

Born on his father's ranch near Buenos Aires, Dick Haymes comes from English parents, who lived in the U.S.A. before going to South America. Dick's mother was a musical comedy star and after retiring from the stage she taught singing in New York. Dick Haymes made his debut at the age of 15, appearing in an amateur production in New Jersey. As a vocalist for Harry James, Dick Haymes began his climb to the top which eventually took him to radio and movies as a singing star. At 4.0 p.m. today 4ZB will broadcast a programme by Dick Haymes and the Mills Brothers.

The distinctive voice of America's Nat King Cole is by now well known to New Zealand listeners who probably possess defined opinions about the style of vocalising in which he specialises. King Cole fans will be catered for by 2ZA at 8.45 this evening.

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
