Many well-known personalities have shown determination in conquering handicaps, but few have fought and won a more courageous battle than Jane Froman. Miss Froman was crippled in an aircraft accident while on an entertainment tour of Europe. Undaunted by her injuries, she made a second tour overseas to entertain wounded soldiers. She believed that hearing music would be better for the injured than speeches on fortitude and patience, and, although still on crutches, travelled 30,000 miles and gave 95 shows. Her example helped many to find new courage. Some of her songs may be heard from 3ZB at 9.45 tonight.
