And I am really caught!"

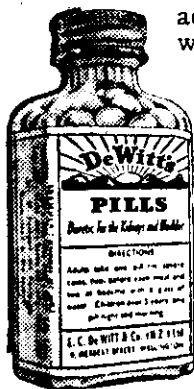
On the strength of the above verse by Richard Armour, 3ZB will present "Catching Tunes" at 5 o'clock this afternoon.
