HOW TO LISTEN TO THE AIR

THE background to the Air Race and news of race preparations will be broadcast in "Air Race Special, scheduled for all YA and YZ stations at 7.0 p.m. each evening from Monday, October 5, to Friday, October 9. This feature will include material sent back by Ulric Williams, the NZBS officer aboard the New Zealand race entry, the R.N.Z.A.F. Hastings, and "Air Race Special" will include some progress results. The map printed here has been designed to help listeners the last edition of follow the race bulletins. Each square on it is numbered for quick reference, and these numbers will be used by announcers when giving the reported positions of the planes. Details of the NZBS cover of the race appear below.


