

What is Bandspread? A Bandspread radio has the 'short-wave' magnified and then split up into a number of separate wavebands. Each of these wavebands (there are seven apart from Broadcast on this fully bandspread sel) occupies the same space on the dial as the short wave on an ordinary set, Because the so-colled 'short wave' is cobut 16 times bagger with handspreading it's about 16 times casier to tune. Stations that were too close together and interfering with one another are easily separated. The pictures apposite tell the story. See how much easier it is to selent a station on a bandspread dial (lower picture) than an ardinary 'short wave' dial.




Stations on an ordinary short wave
