He became a staff pianist for the CBS radio network in 1934 and while there he formed his famous Quintet. The Quintet went to Hollywood and appeared in films in 1936-1937. He returned to the CBS as conductor of a specially selected jazz orchestra around 1942. Raymond Scott and his Quintet will be heard from 4ZB this afternoon at 4.15.
