Originally a dance band vocatist, Dorothy Lamour rose to Hollywood stardom on the strength of her roles as a sultry desert island castaway. In the course of a long and successful film career she has recorded many of the songs she introduced so effectively for Hollywood and some of these are to be presented by IZB in "South Sea Swing," at 11.0 a.m. today.

Of the several roles in musical comedy written specially for Ethel Merman, that of the ambassadress in "Call Me Madam" was perhaps her most successful, although "Annie Get Your Gun" would run it a close second. Her brassy, infectious style of humour irritates some, but her admirers say she can do no wrong. She is the artist to be heard from 2ZB at 4.0 p.m. today.
