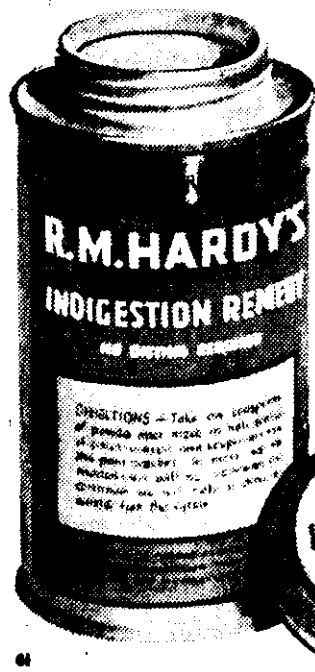

Originally a dance band vocalist, Dorothy Lamour rose to Hollywood stardom on the strength of her roles as a sultry desert island castaway.
