Experiments have been tried on some French railways for warming passenger cars by a stove, which is placed outside. It is said a single stove is sufficient for a whole car, and the expense is very small indeed, 26 pounds of coal keeping up the fires for about 200 miles. Their warm air circulates inside the car.
