Here is how to make it:

1 quart Highlander milk (14)	$\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon Vanilla
2 tablespoons sugar	$\frac{1}{2}$ tablespoon maizena
	4 eggs (whites beaten separately)

METHOD: Boil the milk and pour it over the maizena, which has been previously mixed with a little of the cold milk; boil five minutes, and add sugar and flavouring. When the mixture is slightly cooled, add the beaten whites of the eggs. Return the mixture to the range and keep stirring about three minutes. Pour into a buttered mould, serve with cream, and make with the yolk and Highlander milk.
