PROTESTANTISM AND CATHOLICISM



FEW weeks ago our Presbyterian contemporary, the Outlook, published in its editorial columns a striking article making a comparison, or rather drawing a contrast, between present-day Protestantism and the vigor, coherence, and vitality of Catholicism. We reproduced the greater portion of the article in our columns; and its candor, truth, and thoughtfulness elicited

widespread comment amongst our readers. The point of the article was that Catholicism was everywhere growing in strength and influence and that Protestantism was everywhere declining; and the reasons assigned for this phenomenon were the definiteness and certitude of Catholicism, and the element of doubt and uncertainty generally prevailing in Protestant circles. 'It cannot be too strongly insisted upon,' said the Outlook, 'that the Roman Catholicism of the present day is essentially Consistent, Coherent, and Convinced of the truth of the doctrines she enforces. Opposed to this in Protestant and Presbyterian pulpits and literathis in Processant and Press, butter is an element of Chaos, Doubt, and Agnosticism. The Roman Catholic authorities say, "I know"; the average Protestant doubtingly essays, "I am not sure." Hence the note of authority formerly so prominent in Protestant preaching and teaching has largely been
