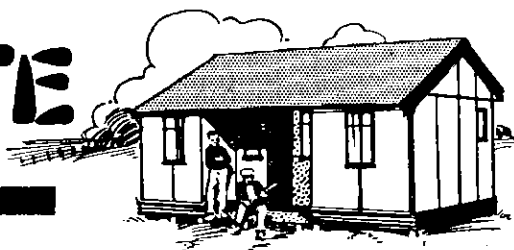


POILITE
