Comparative Cost

Owing to the fact that misleading comparisons are often made of the relative cost of Roofs covered with Corrugated Iron or "Poilite" Tiles, we have obtained the following figures from a Quantity Surveyor in Dunedin. These estimates are based on Dunedin town rates for March, 1914.

Roof Construction:—26 Gauge G.C.	
4in. x 2in. R.P. Rafters at 36in. centres: - 62ft. super R.P. at 17/- per 100ft. Labor per square 7/6: Cartage 6d.: Nails 5d	£ s. d. £ s. d. 10 6 8 5

Cost per square	for IRON Roof £3 11 0
If 24 gauge G.C. Iron is used instead of 26 guage, add per square	10s. 6d.
If roof is painted with two coats English Oxide, add per square	7s. 7d.
