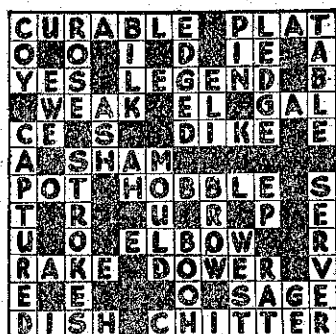


Solution of No. 4,

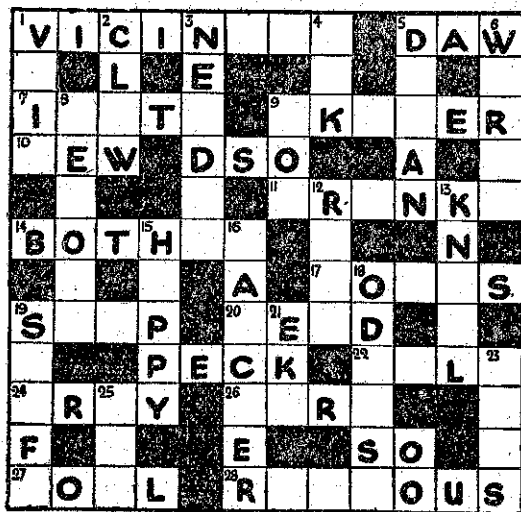

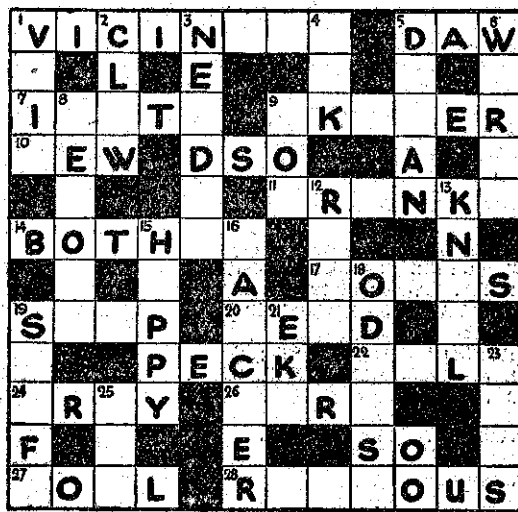
