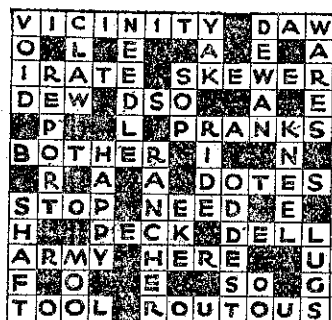




Results of "Kia Ora" Crossword Competition No. 5

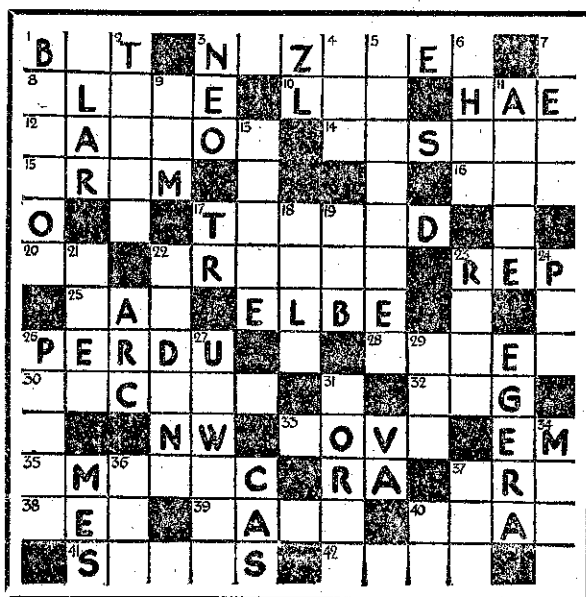
