D.—Dunedin and Southland.

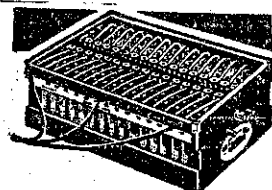
The prefix is N.Z.; then follows the district letter, then the personal identity number. The following is a list of N.Z. members:—
