Sizes 12-14 and 14-16 years.

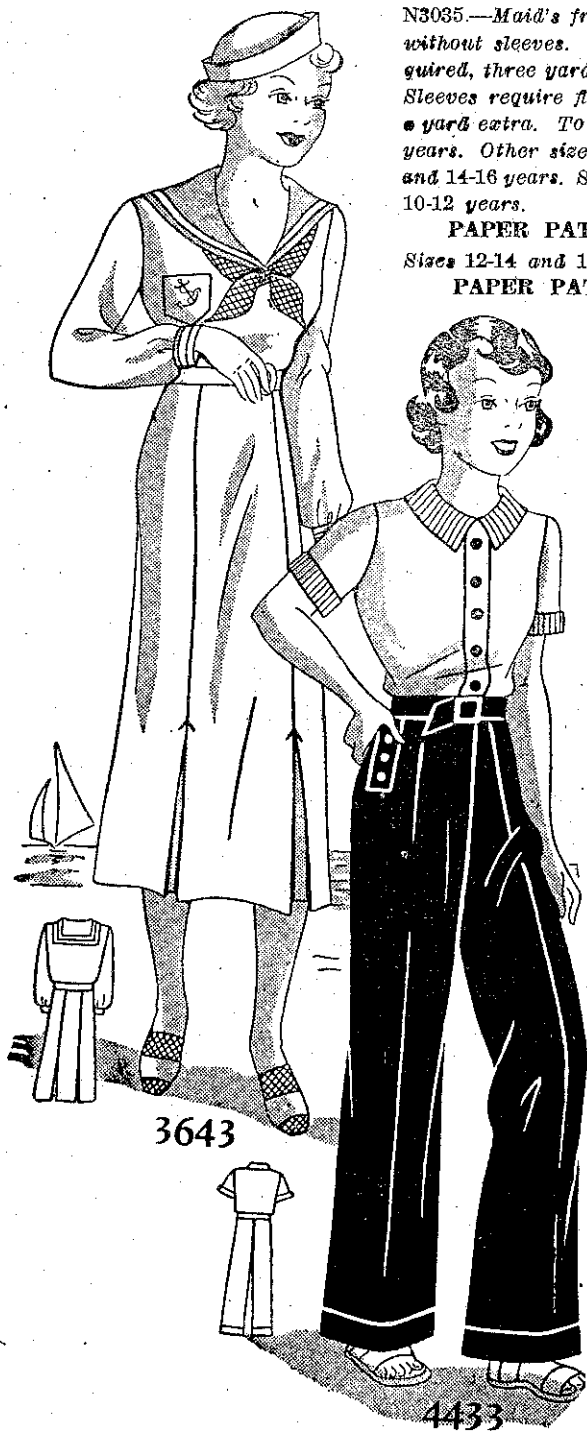
PAPER PATTERN, 1/1
