What is required :

Each of the eighteen jumbled lines contains the exact words forming a quotation (a proverb or other extract) taken from English literature. There are no words to be added or taken away.

What is required is to arrange the words in each line in proper order, as originally written by the authors.

Rules and Conditions.

Answers to at least twelve of the lines must be sent, but include more answers in solution if possible.

The prize of £40 will be paid to the person whose solution contains the largest number of correct answers. The prize will be divided in event of ties.

To send solution, write on a sheet of paper 12 or more answers, in numerical order. Add, "Above is my solution of 'Jumbled Quotations,' No. 1, as advertised in 'N.Z. Radio Record.'"

Sign name and full address. No addressed envelope need be sent. Full results will be advertised in this paper on May 3rd.
