

such a prospect would fill him with dismay. He is merely buying an audience. He refuses to admit that his unlovely exterior is merely the reflection of the man he has chosen to be. He is what he is making himself. Cancer is his probable fate—for he is cancerous already in mind.

How did Christ heal such a one? By the clarity of His perception of the truth—that the appearance being presented to the world was false: that the real Mr. A. is perfect, as God's picture of him must ever be. The influence of Christ's love and the intensity of his consciousness of the true nature of Mr. A. restored Mr. A.'s faith in good and his faith in himself.

Error was corrected and healing instantaneous. The delivered man went on his way rejoicing.

### Agonised Apprehension.

A LADY similarly afflicted, continually complains that it is because of the assorted aches and pains, because of her flatulence and palpitation, because of her neuritis and stiffened joints that she is so miserable and ill. She points out, with pride, that when the pains don't trouble her she feels happy and well. This is not true. She is never happy or well. Her spells of freedom from discomfort are periods of agonised apprehension lest, when her wretchedness returns, she suffer

more acutely than before. She is always despondent, except when some outward event deflects her attention, temporarily, from herself. She is a victim of fear. She wails that she has no faith. But it is negatively directed; and, consequently, is directing the vital dynamic within to her own undoing.

Like the world to-day, she is fear ridden. She has a perfectly pathetic faith in evil. If she had one-tenth of the faith in good and its unchallengeable power, that she is evidencing to-day in its opposite, her recovery would be reckoned a miracle.

### WE'LL HAVE APRICOT MOULD!

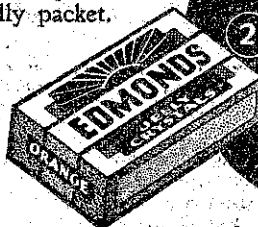
