STRAIN jellies, coffee or barley-water through butter muslin, which also makes soft dish-cloths, polishing-cloths and "throw-away" handkerchiefs. Used double, butter muslin makes an excellent press-cloth on the ironing-table.

To remove dirt, grease, and stains of any kind from furniture use a mixture of methylated spirits, vinegar, and paraffin in equal proportions. When dusting furniture use a duster which

has been soaked in paraffin and allowed to dry for three days. Another method is to dip a wash-leather in warm water to which has been added sufficient vinegar to give it an aromatic smell. Then wring out the washleather till nearly dry and rub the article well. This will remove all ordinary marks and leave an excellent polish on the furniture. To remove white marks on mahogany caused by hot plates, rub well with a piece of flannel dipped in

linseed oil. Then polish with a soft duster. Where there are any scratches on the furniture, rub half of a Brazil nut into the damaged parts, and the oil which the nut contains will bring the surface up to its normal level.

WHEN opening cardboard flour packets, cut them along the side instead of at the top. They make handy lunch-boxes, or can be used to carry cakes or sandwiches to picnics.
