

#### Mendelssohn's Hymn Of Praise Wins A King's Approval

THE Saxon city of Leipzig was judiciously about music. In the second part of the concert, "The Hymn of Praise" was given, and at its close the King leit his reat and tion of printing in June, 1840. The Germans of the early The Germans of the early nineteenth century, in all innocence had their festival, however, and part of the extensive music-making on that occasion was the production for the first time of Mendelssohn's "Hymn of Praise" written expressly for the festival.

The performance took place in Bach's old church of St. Thomas, and later in the same year "The and later in the same year "The Hymn of Praise" was repeated for the King of Saxony.

On this occasion the King sent for Mendelssohn in the early part of the concert and spoke very

sages that pleased him most, after thanking all the singers, he took his departure, while the whole orchestra and the whole audience, made the very best bows and curtsies they could accomplish.

In "Hymn of Praise," Mendelssohn appears to have heen toying with a new construction, seeking to attain a kind of unity for the whole work by making use of a leading musical phrase or motto. He chose for his motto a splendid example, an ancient church mode, the sole function of whose few noble notes was to climb the scale with the slow dignity, the set, upward look of a Parsifal motive.

Under Mr. Frederick Bullock, the Royal Christchurch Musical Society will present "Hymn of Praise" on Wednesday, Novem-ber 30. This performance will be relayed by 3YA.
