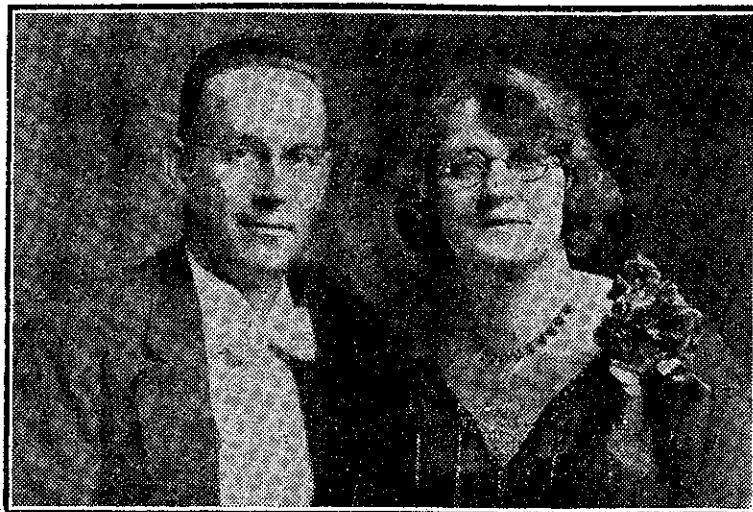




MR. CHAS. LAMBERG.
