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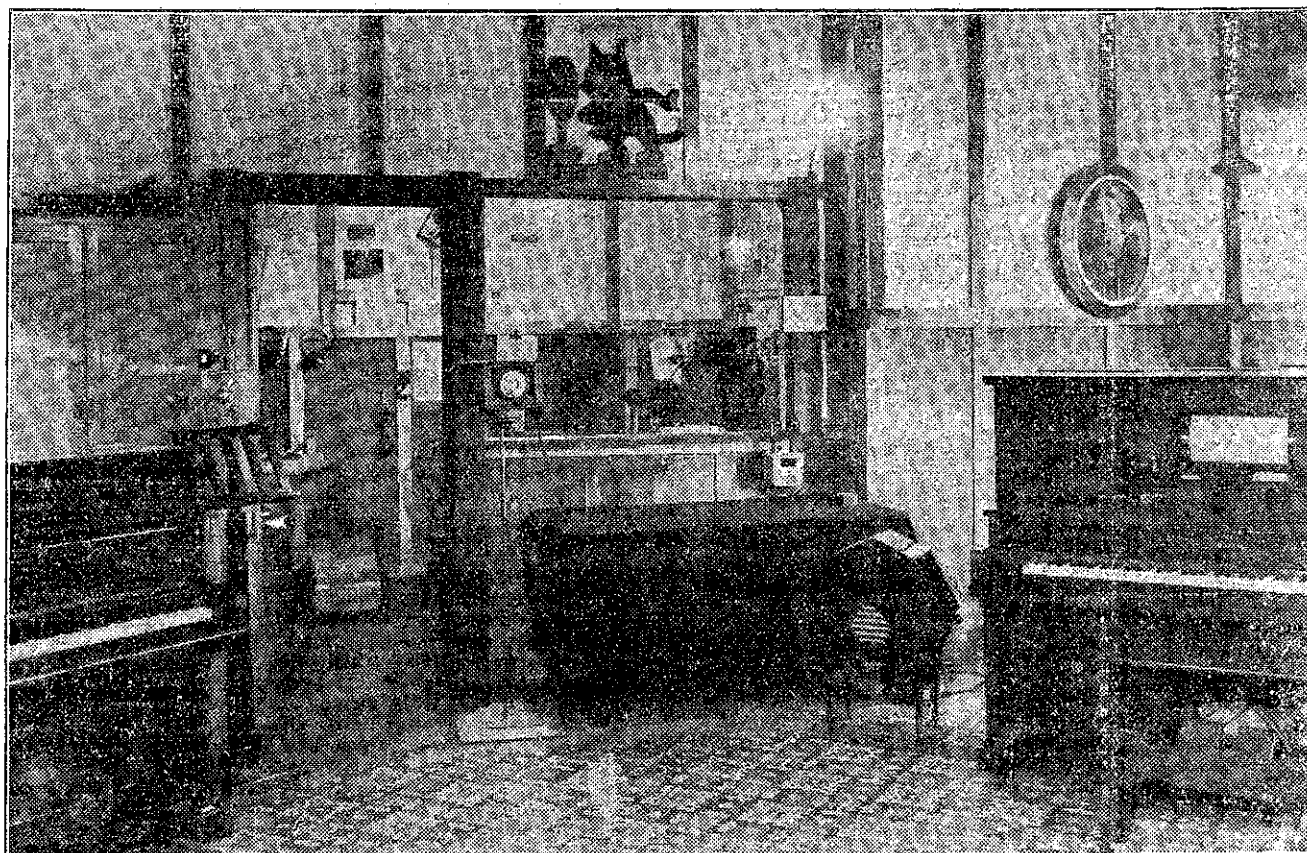

In the background is the announcer's studio, which contains all the amplifiers, relay line switches, and gramophone turntables, arranged so that they may be conveniently controlled by one operator.
