

Te Kooti. Te Kooti, who will be the subject of a talk from 4YA on Thursday next, was one of the most parodoxical of Maori chieftains. Starting his career as a more or less re-ligious Macri, who was described by the settlers of Poverty Bay as "diffi-cult," he was transported to the Chathams without a trial, later to escape and become one of the most crafty leaders whose general-ship was second only to that of de Witt. The terror of Poverty Bay, northern Hawke's Bay, Taupo Plains, and the Waikato, and for years an outlaw with a price of £5000 on his head, he lived to mix on equal terms with white men, to shake hands with a Minister of the Crown, and to die in the respectability of a full pardon. He was a dominating personality, a master of guerrilla warfare; a general whose word was law, who thought out his plans carefully and executed them with enterprise, energy, and completeness; a man of relentless ferocity, who would break through the best laid cordons and reappear where least expect-He was the principal figure in the last series of campaigns that when finished were to leave New Zealand in lasting peace.


