similar approach but don't quite cut it. Never mind — worth it for

Psykke alone.
Massacre, who have a cassette to themselves, go for a more straightforward punk sound.

They're young and raw with a more mid-tempo feel than many Finnish groups but don't come up to the

quality of some of their country-men (Riisteyt, Terveet Kadet) although they are quite appealing


