Quotas will make a difference but probably more to mainstream music and not particularly ours. However, recording standards on Flying Nun have steadily improved at a pace that's financially sensible and I would expect that, for instance, 'Husband House' by Sneaky Feelings and the Chills' music should be able to get on commercial radio. Radio play is important, records sell as a result. We certainly notice the difference when student stations go off the air. It is important when you put out New Zealand music to be able to sell it at home no matter what its export potential is. The market for New Zealand music is spreading beyond the grassroots, where it's always been strong, and heading towards more mainstream and quotas will probably accelerate that movement.
